- Posters must be in English with text easily readable. The poster should include an introduction, conclusion and contact details
- All poster abstracts will be acknowledged
- Poster abstracts will be judged by the Programme Committee and those selected or not selected for display at the conference will be advised by Friday 29 January 2016
- All poster authors should try to be present during break sessions to discuss their posters with delegates although this is not compulsory
- Posters abstracts should be submitted to RQA, 3 Wherry Lane, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP4 1LG, United Kingdom or by email to tward@therqa.com

Terms and conditions

All poster abstracts and final posters must comply with the following guidelines:

1. All posters must be in English.
2. Ensure all contact details are correct.
3. The content of the poster must not be promotional or contain advertising although commercial logos are acceptable.
4. Poster display does not constitute registration to the conference. All authors attending must register separately.
5. Changes to accepted posters will be considered on an individual basis. All changes must be notified to the Programme Committee.
